HERE AT THE ACADEMY WE USE SOFTWARE FOR BLOCKING AND MONITORING STUDNETS ACTIVITY ONLINE TO KEEP THEM SAFE. SENSO SOFTWARE IS USED FOR NETWORK, CLASSROOM, SAFEGUARDING AND ICT MANAGEMENT HERE AT THE ACDEMY.

IF STUDNETS HAVE BEEN SEARCHING FOR INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT OR MESSAGES AN AUTOMATIC SCREEN GRAB WILL BE SENT IMMIDIATELY VIA EMAIL EVEN IF THEY DELETE IT. THESE ALERTS GO TO TO THEIR SAFEGUARDING YEAR LEAD AND DSL.

LADO (Local Authority Designated Officer)

Legislation and guidance from government sets out the processes to be followed by agencies when responding to allegations against adults who work with children and young people: Working Together 2018, Keeping Children Safe in Education 2021 and BSCP's Procedures for Managing Allegations against People who work with Children. All allegations that meet the allegation criteria must be reported to the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) within one working day.

If you believe there is immediate risk of significant harm contact the Police on 999. If you believe there are significant safeguarding concerns, you can contact Integrated Front Door via www.bolton.gov.uk/refer-a-child
